The General Assembly is in its 135th term. (2023-2024).

Over all there are 5000 bills introduced each year, but only about 150 bills actually become law. Presently there are 22 bills having to do with education. A couple of the bills that affect most schools are

BillHB 38 Allow school districts to permit students three metal health days.

HB 12 Rename and revises duties of Department of Education and Workforce.

HB 9 Establish the Grow Your Own Teacher Program

 $\ensuremath{\mathsf{HB}}$ 348 Create pilot programs to increase student attendance , graduation

HB266 require schools to update EMS plans or individual with disability.

SB29 Regards education records and student data privacy.

SB49 Enact the Religious Expression Days
